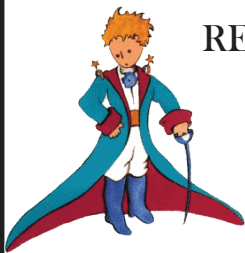
Annual poetry reading. Haiku Festival celebrates children through poetry, while promoting literacy, through year-round events for poets of all ages.

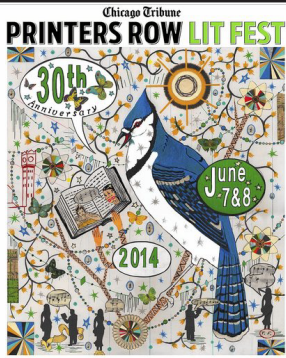
